
The Royal Edinburgh Military Tattoo

Our sustainable Scottish Atlantic halibut dish is delicately slow cooked and prepared with flavours of courgette and our own cured halibut sauce. Fresh Orkney scallops are hand dived and accompanied with a leek chowder and smoked roe that really bring out the flavours of the ocean.

Make sure to taste our very own honey that is often included in one of our desserts. It is harvested from our apiary on the rooftop of The Balmoral and is delicately looked after by the team.

Then finish the evening with a selection of delicious artisan cheeses from our local supplier I.J. Mellis, renowned for their knowledge and sourcing in the finest quality produce.



AFTER 30 YEARS WITH THE BALMORAL HOW DO YOU FEEL?


