Wilde Nights £22

'Alas, I am dying beyond my means' quipped Oscar Wilde, as he sipped Champagne on his deathbed. This beguiling cocktail, laced with Irish whiskey and a spray of absinthe, is served in an Art Deco glass. It's perfect for some Wilde-in-exile decadence.

Black Bush Irish whiskey, green Chartreuse, homemade apple vermouth, spray of absinthe, Acqua Bianca, splash of Champagne. 


Trust In Me £21

Swing into the spirit of the tropics with this cocktail inspired by *The Jungle Book*, reputedly penned at Brown's by Rudyard Kipling. Let the fresh kick of pine liqueur and edible flowers transport you to a tropical rainforest.

Pisco, Pino Mugo, pineapple and green cardamom marmalade, lime juice, London Essence roasted pineapple soda. 


The Honey Bear £20

In the wise words of AA Milne's character Eeyore, 'It never hurts to keep looking for sunshine.' This sunshine-filled bear hug of a cocktail has honey notes in a homage to Winnie-the-Pooh as Milne was a regular at Brown's.

Campari, rhubarb cordial, Sassy Cidre Brut, honey. 

From Mayfair With Love £22

Kingsley Amis, author of James Bond novel, Colonel Sun, was a Brown's aficionado. An ode to a Vesper Martini, 007 has come to Mayfair with this sun-drenched cocktail. The garnish is a surprising secret awaiting to be discovered.

Grey Goose vodka re-distilled with calendula, Bombay premier cru gin, white wine reduction, spray of black olive leaf tea. 

The Elementary £13

This old-fashioned smoky virgin drink has an energising shot of tea, making it as mercurial as the swish of Sherlock's cape in the London moonlight. It is inspired by Sherlock's creator, Sir Arthur Conan Doyle, and his family, who were loyal to Brown's.

Or Wells That End Wells £20

Heaven may well be a white negroni – rare and refined, much like Orson Welles himself – often called the greatest filmmaker of all time. Celebrate the stylish sixties with this spirited take of Welles' time at the hotel.

Re-distilled Campari, dry vermouth, Marine Everleaf, orange bitter. 


Reed Between The Lines £21

Embrace your alter-naughty ego with this feisty cocktail inspired by the life of actor Oliver Reed. Of course, it is whisky-based and belligerent but also smoothly playful in honour of its mischievous namesake.

Dewar's Illegal smooth whisky fat washed with salty butter, barley wine reduction, lemon juice, Bénédictine, Angostura bitters. 


The Interval £22

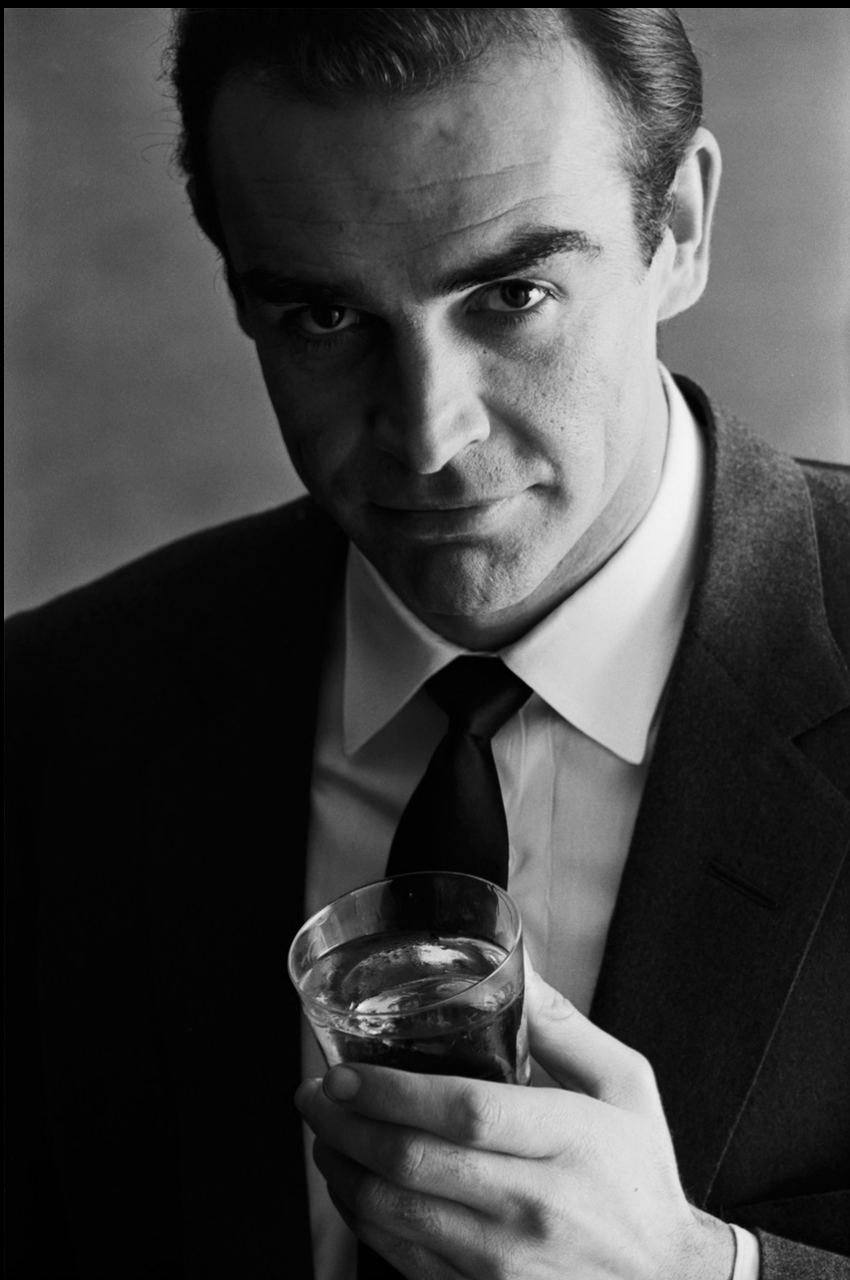

Named in honour of our greatest leader, Winston Churchill, who also loved the bar at Brown's. Theatrically served in a bubble-shaped glass, this 'British bulldog' whisky cocktail has complex undertones of mandarin and eucalyptus with a swirl of cigar in his honour.

Let's Be Franklin £20

'FDR', the 32nd President of the United States, honeymooned at Brown's and, just like us, held cocktail hour sacred. A base of rich Cuban rum lends a naturally spirited note to this potent experience.

Eminente Reserva 7 yrs rum, Angostura bitters, lime juice, orgeat. 


The Milky Way £22

Looking back to the first Forte offering, a Milk Bar in Scotland. Our homage to Lord Charles Forte is a nod to his meteoric rise and legacy, combining a dash of Scotch whisky with almond milk infused with Italian flavours of strawberry or mint. *Salute and slàinte!*

Hoxton gin, Ardbeg whisky, manzanilla sherry, coconut syrup, almond milk, crème de menthe or strawberry cordial. 


Si, Maestro £23

Tickle your senses with this love letter to the Italian coast by the renowned Salvatore Calabrese. A teasing twist on his famous Breakfast Martini. Mingling cognac with Amalfi lemon marmalade notes, this is a sophisticated number worthy of the Maestro.

Don't Be Greedy £13

The dame of crime, Agatha Christie, was one of our greatest Afternoon Tea fans, and based one of her books on Brown's. This mocktail with a mission combines layers of pure fig syrup and apple with a zippy fizz of jasmine and peach.

Fig purée, apple juice, lemon juice, Earl Grey and vanilla tea, orange juice, egg white.

In honour of our 185th anniversary, delve into the decadence of our illustrious past with this elegant cocktail, flavoured with bittersweet Amaro Lucano. Italy's famed liqueur was developed from a secret family recipe, concocted by Cavalier Pasquale Vena in 1894.

Awamori Tsuchi, Amaro Lucano, Mancino vermouth rosso amaranto, Grand Marnier, orange juice, cherry air. 


Speechless £23

You'll be all starry eyed with this sparkling gold cocktail, which is infused with tropical notes of banana rum and papaya punch. Join us to celebrate the opulence of the BAFTAs and its first ceremony, held at Brown's in 1947.

Patrón Reposado tequila, lemon juice, Muyu Chinotto liqueur, Ruinart Brut Champagne. 


Harry's Star £22

A seductive White Lady-inspired cocktail in honour of the most famous bartender of the Jazz Age, Harry Craddock, who was at the helm of the bar at Brown's in the 1940s. Be all the rage as we enter the new 'Roaring '20s' with this jaunty, spicy tipple.

The First Call £23

A playful nod to Alexander Graham Bell who famously invented the 'blower' and made the first call from it at Brown's. Punchy Elephant Gin spiced with pistachio pesto is at the heart of this Instagram-ready cocktail.

Make a splash with this buzzing mocktail, in honour of the Niagara Commission meeting at Brown's in 1890. Non-alcoholic bubbles combined with an equally virtuous spirit and a spicy oomph of agave syrup makes this a stimulatingly refreshing tonic.
