Troika ride

When St Petersburg turns into a snow-capped wonderland, there's no more entrancing experience than a traditional troika ride through the Pavlovsk Park – the grounds of Tsar Paul I's Pavlovsk Palace. Start your adventure with a tour of the 18th-century palace, then enjoy an exhilarating horse-drawn ride through its expansive landscaped park – warmed with classic local snacks and vodka.

Russian banya

Steaming in heats of up to 90 degrees, the bathing ritual includes "venik" brushing, where bathers are treated with birch or oak branches infused with a secret recipe of aromatic oils. A sure-fire way to recover from a long day, flight or late night.
